

that fitted within our budget,' Andrew says. 'As well as finding a way to fit a new WC under the stairs, they also included cost-saving proposals - for example, by recommending we swap the expensive glass roof I wanted over the side return for a row of three standard roof lights, I was able to create a similar effect for a fraction of the cost.'

Favouring a classic kitchen design in keeping with the period of the property, Andrew opted for Shaker-style units painted in complementary tones of dark grey and white, teamed with an oak worktop to match the wooden flooring. A vintage dining table and traditional cast-iron radiator contrast with more modern elements, such as the bar stools, dining chairs and industrial-style pendant lights, creating a bold scheme that's filled with character.
