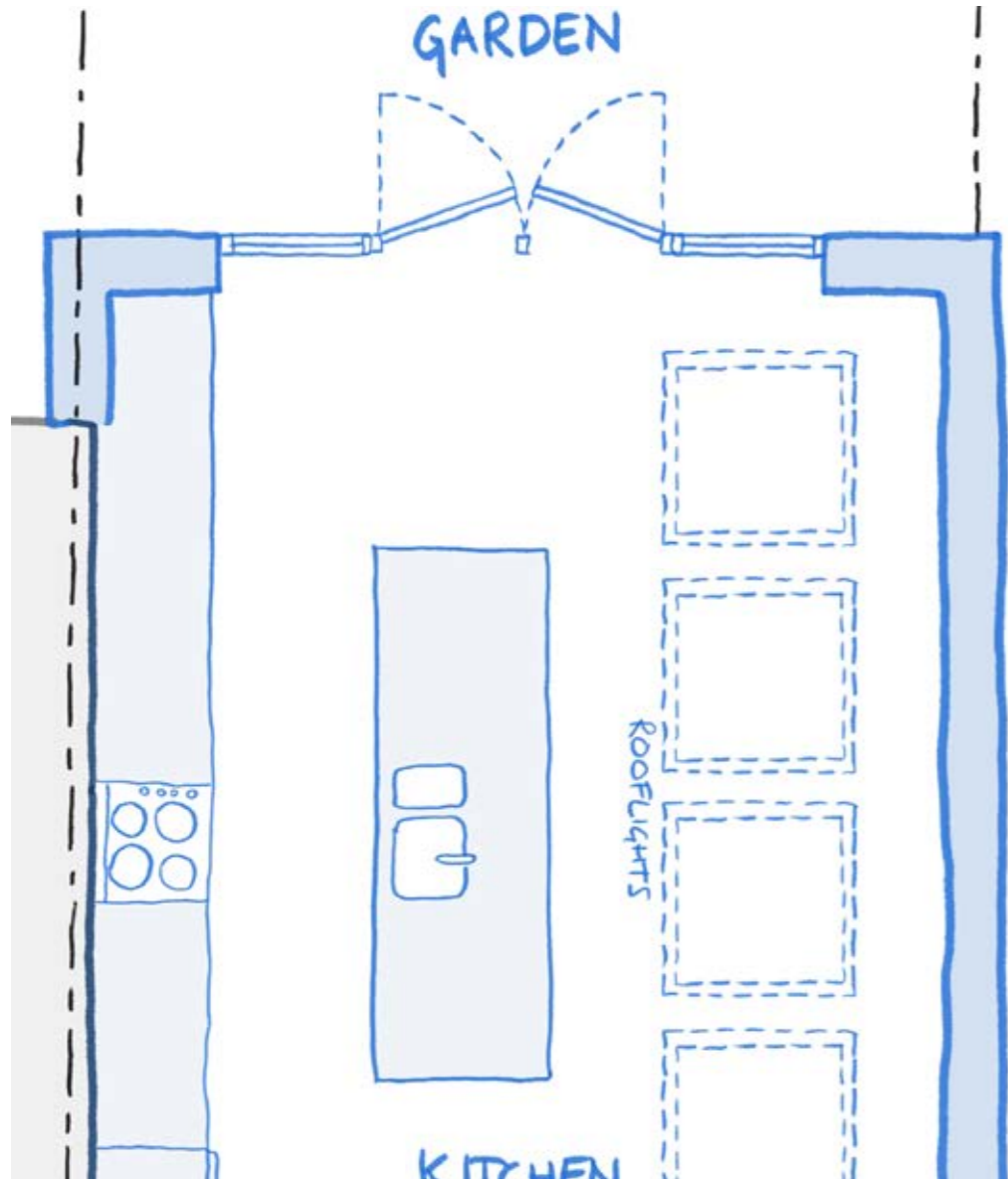


INTRODUCTION

PROJECT PROFILE

Extension Type: Wraparound Ground Floor Extension

Size: 28 SQM

Duration: 14 Weeks

Budget: £90,000 + VAT

One of Build Team's most popular projects is the complete renovation and extension of this family home in Finsbury Park.

The new space is flooded with natural light, thanks to the four large architectural skylights along the side return, and the full width Crittall doors which lead directly onto a landscaped garden.

We also completed a full refurbishment of the ground floor, adding a Crittall screen between the front reception rooms. It is now a breathtaking home they proudly show off to family and friends while entertaining.

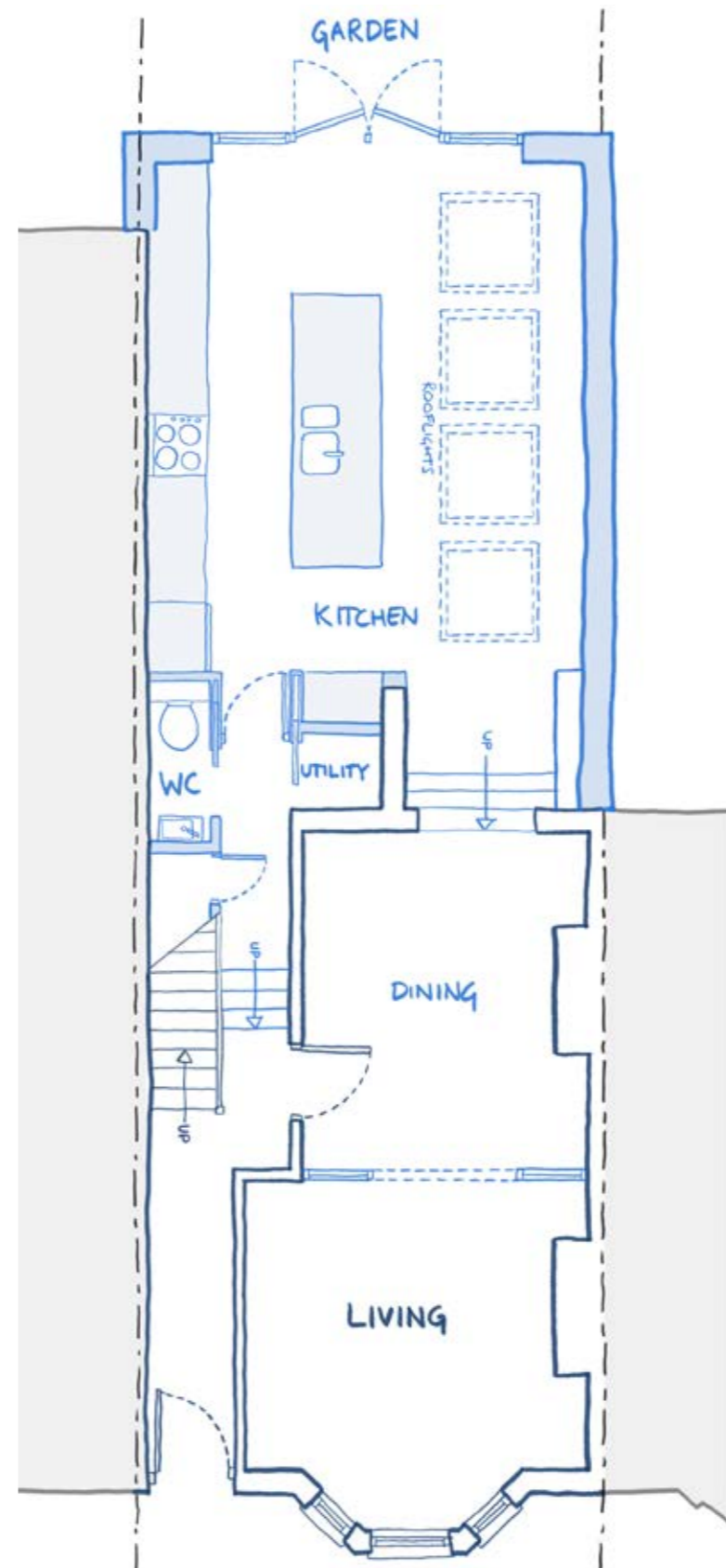

KEY FEATURES

01 Ash Wood Floor:

The floor in this kitchen is light and hard-wearing, adding a Scandinavian feel.

02 Kitchen Island:

This statement piece gives plenty of additional surface space, and the light finish draws the eye towards the garden.

03 Statement Lighting:

This is a little detail that can quite often get missed, but statement lighting adds warmth and style.





04 Crittall Style Doors:

These steel frame doors are a timeless, yet industrial, feature.

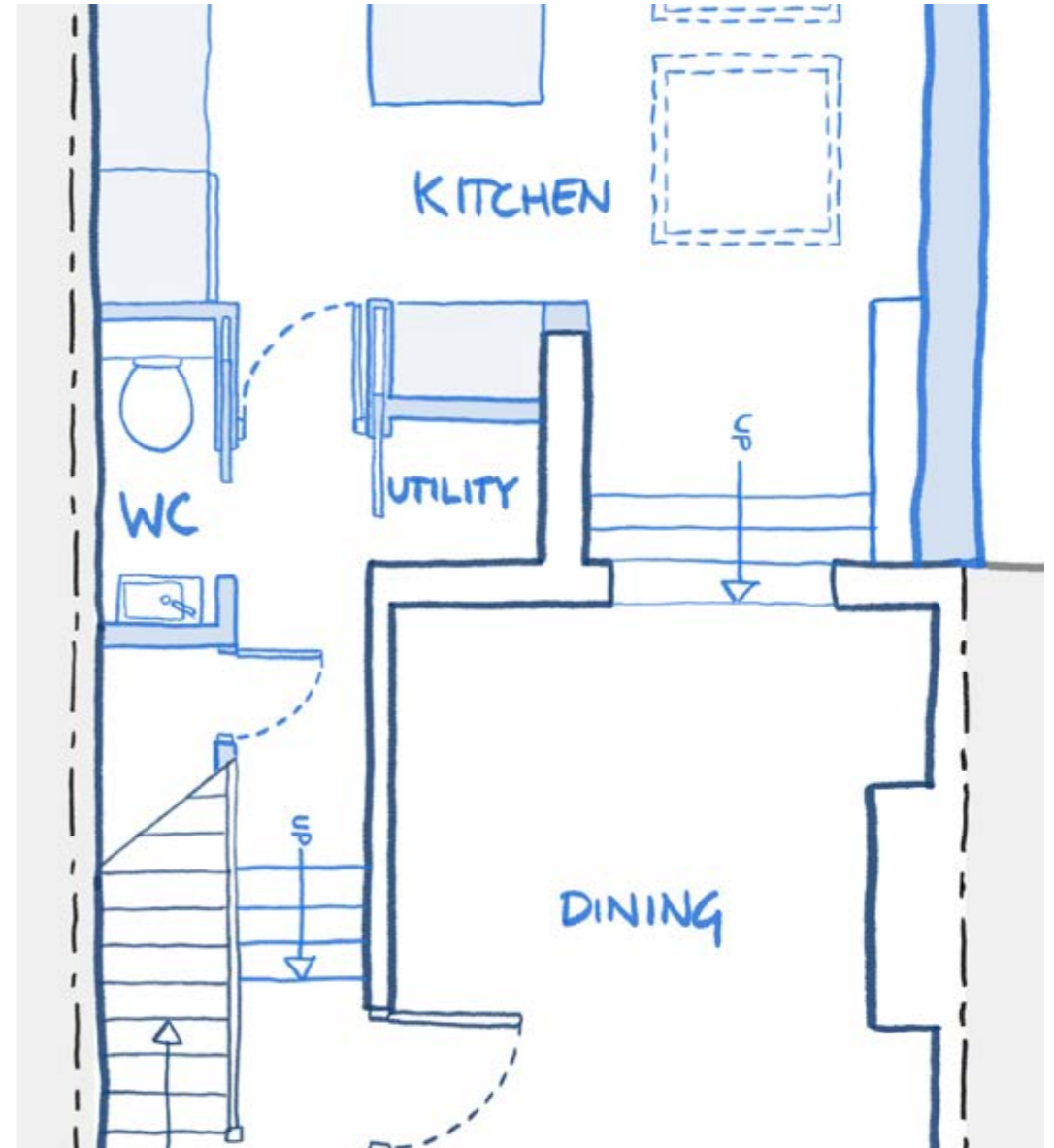
05 Architectural Rooflights:

There are four skylights measuring 1.5 metres long, which flood the room with natural light.

06 Bench Seat:

Perfect for little bottoms, this custom bench also has some very useful hidden storage.
