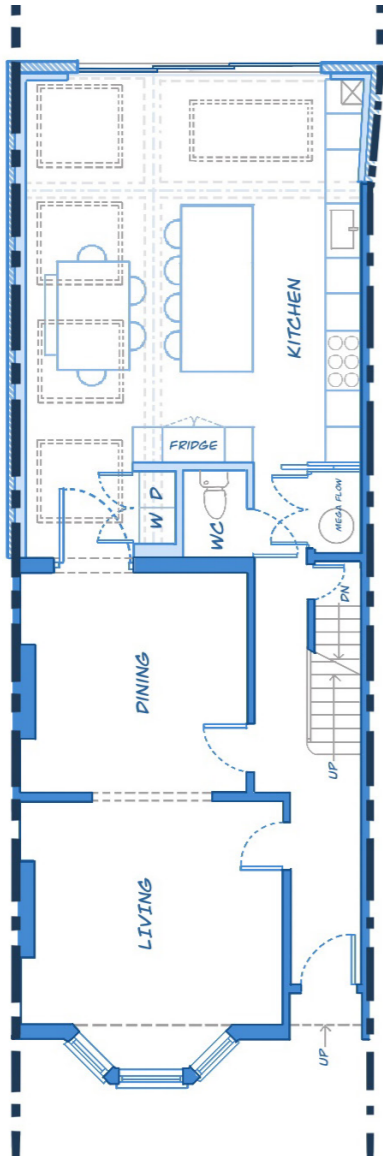

PROJECT PROFILE

Extension Type: Wraparound Ground Floor Extension

Size: 50 SQM

Duration: 14 Weeks

Budget: £87,000 + VAT

We have transformed our clients Victorian terrace property in North London, completing the design and build of this beautiful ground floor wraparound extension.

This kitchen extension exemplifies a contemporary design that enhances both functionality and aesthetic appeal. We have included large skylights and a full-height/full-width sliding doors that open to the garden, maximising natural light and visual connection to the outdoors. It transforms the original layout by expanding the kitchen into the garden area, creating a spacious, light-filled hub for cooking, dining, and socialising.

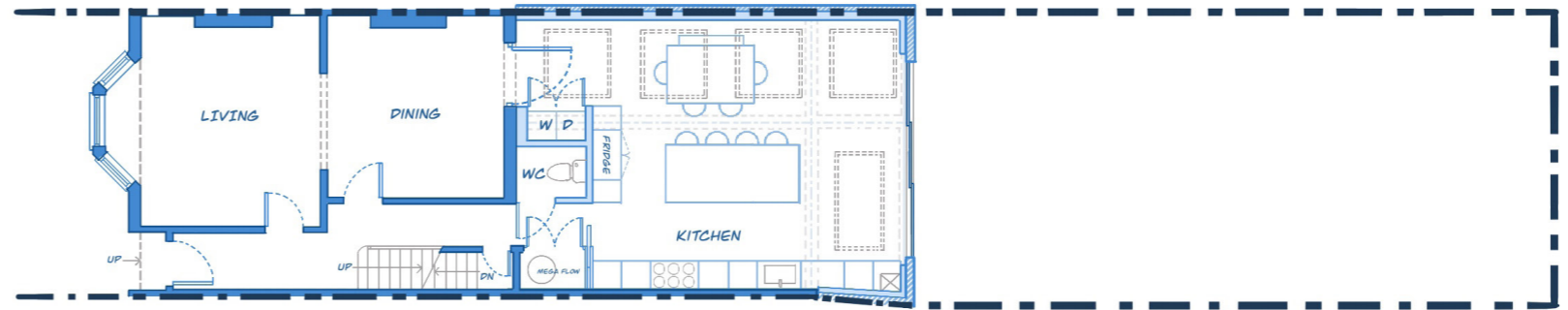

KEY FEATURES

- 01 Herringbone Wood Floor:
Adds texture and visual interest while maintaining a cohesive natural palette
- 02 Central Kitchen Island:
Serves as a multifunctional space for prep, dining, and gathering. The white marble worktop contrasts beautifully with the green cabinetry.
- 03 Open Shelving:
Enhances accessibility and allows for personalized styling with plants and ceramics.
- 04 Integrated Appliances:
The black double oven, seamlessly built into the cabinetry for a sleek look.



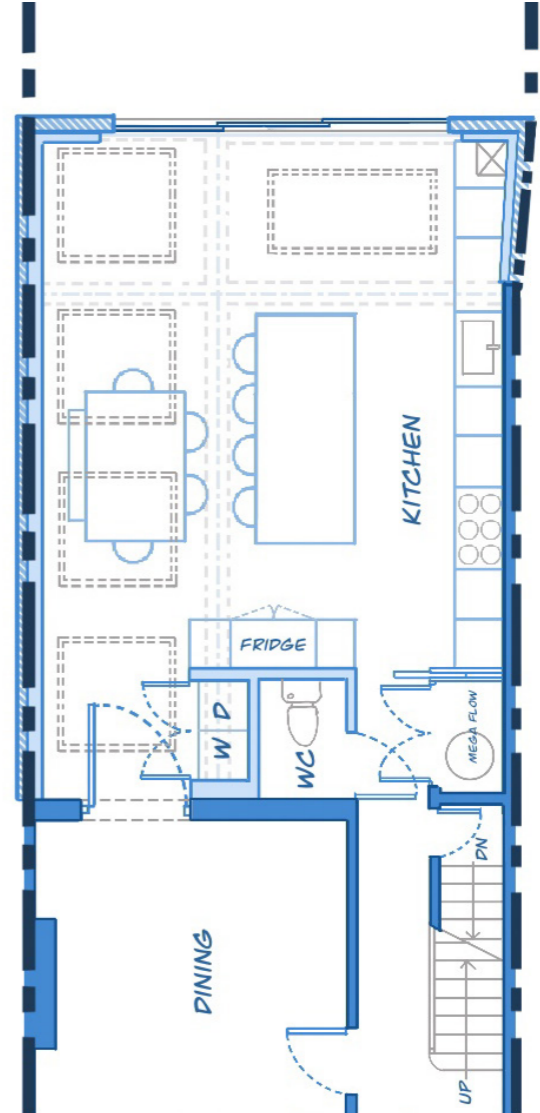


05 Olive Green Matte Cabinetry:
Adds warmth and sophistication, complemented by brass hardware for a touch of luxury.

06 Pendant Lighting:
Three white-shaded brass pendant lights above the island create a focal point and provide task lighting.

07 Large Glazing Elements:
The Velux rooflights, large Architectural Skylight & slim-framed sliding doors maximises the natural light and visual connection to the outdoors.
